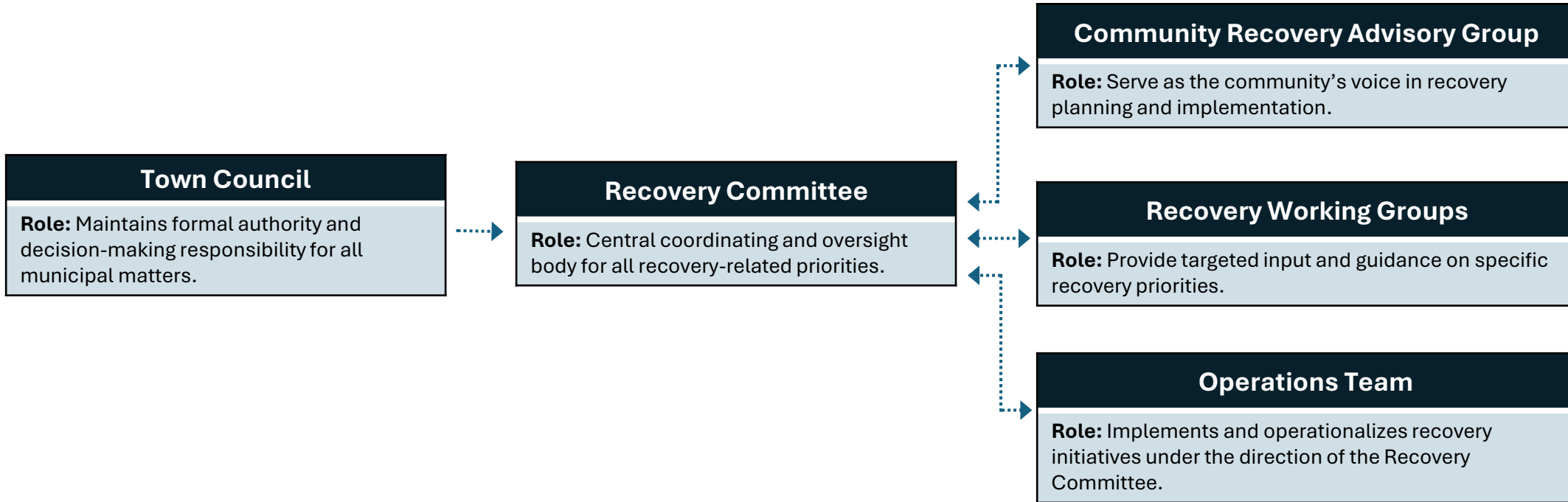

Priority Areas

- **1. Social and Community Wellbeing**
 - Social gathering, mental health and wellbeing, community engagement, capacity building
- **2. Housing and Community Infrastructure**
 - Equitable housing access, rebuilding and repair, navigational support, community infrastructure renewal, strategic community planning
- **3. Public Safety and Environment**
 - Rehabilitation and hazard mitigation, community-based safety programs, emergency preparedness and coordination, public education and awareness

- **Aim for Progress** - Tonight's goal is to leave with clear priorities and actions - even if we can't solve everything today.
