Community Foundations of Newfoundland and Labrador (CFNL)

Community Wildfire Prevention and Mitigation Program

The Town is pleased to announce that we have received funding for **\$35,000 to create a resilience plan** as part of the Newfoundland and Labrador Community Wildfire Prevention and Mitigation Program. This funding is **phase 1** of the program, with additional funding opportunities to open in the coming months.

We will continue to update on this initiative as it moves forward.

Newfoundland Power Envirofest Grant

The Town is pleased to announce that we are a **recipient of the \$6000 NL Power Envirofest 2026 grant**. This funding will go towards the **remediation of the Ballfield Trailhead Greenspace** to support increased access and recreation.

Story Sharing Workshops

Over the course of 3 sessions, **49 community members** came together to **share stories** about their experiences in the **fires**. Through collective writing, some laughter, and some tears, the group has begun the **creation of a radio play and collection of stories**.
