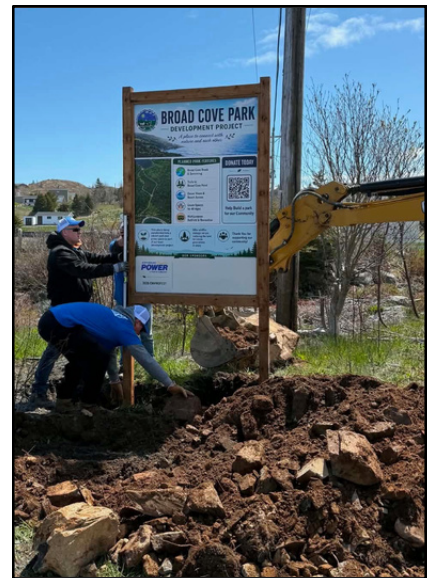


Community Updates
